1) Amenities (Bob, John, Richard, Don) Monthly meeting - FSR & SPM (management) / CS (maintenance) / Axis (contractor)

Lazy River / Lap Pool / Splash Pad - off-season maintenance & repairs -

New Lazy River on schedule to open for 2024 season along with the lap pool, splash pad and existing lazy river. Lap pool, splash pad, and lazy river all operational with maintenance ongoing. There is continuity in staff performing maintenance and new algaecide is working well.

Repairs, re-grouting tile, and refinishing of the lap pool and splash pad surfaces and bathroom flooring as well as repair and replacement of splash pad fixtures is in the proposed 2024 budget awaiting SCA Board approval. Refinishing would take approximately 3 weeks once job is awarded.

Lazy River pumps 9 & 10 were inspected 1/9 and waiting on assessment from electrician for next steps.

All amenities will now be managed by an onsite full-time amenities manager. Responsibilities include managing the services of the the pool maintenance company Commercial Swim, the pool monitors, and the community porters. The job is posted on the First Service Residential website as well as on Indeed.

#### Ponds - Sunfield Parkway Pond rebuild -

All engineering work has been completed and approved. The scope of work is finalized and the job is ready to be posted for bid.
