### Subcommittee updates (40 min / note Chair in **bold**) Review Trello project tracking system

1) Amenities (Bob, John, Richard, Don) Monthly meeting - FSR & SPM (management) / CS (maintenance) / Axis (contractor)

Lazy River / Lap Pool / Splash Pad - off-season maintenance & repairs -All amenities will now be managed by an onsite full-time amenities manager (100+ applications received). Responsibilities include managing the services of the the pool maintenance company Commercial Swim, hiring and supervising the pool monitors, and supervising the community porters as pertains to community amenities. New Lazy River on schedule to open for 24 season along with the lap pool, splash pad and existing lazy river. Concern @ new LR opening expressed. Lap pool, splash pad, and lazy river 1 operational w/ maintenance ongoing. Repairs, re-grouting tile, and refinishing of the lap pool and splash pad surfaces and bathroom flooring as well as repair and replacement of splash pad fixtures included in the proposed 2024 budget awaiting SCA Board approval. Lazy River pumps 9 & 10 were inspected 1/9. Pump 9 controller to be replaced, pump 10 waiting on additional assessment from electrician for next steps. A new fault indicated in Pump 1 which is to be inspected under warranty.

Ponds - Sunfield Parkway Pond rebuild -

Project posted for bid. Bid anticipated to be awarded in March and work to begin April /May as weather allows. Playground @ Reunion Pavilion -

Caitlin to ask PlayWell to bid the addition of a playground to Reunion Pavilion.

2) Infrastructure / Landscaping (John, Richard, Bill, Jen, Sagar, Lalit, Michael)

Landscape replacement - Caitlin requested original landscape design documents from SunGrow and meeting with SunGrow 2/12 to identify specific replacement areas and replacement plant material. Pending budget approval.

Cherrystone Loop perimeter landscaping - Caitlin to investigate status of irrigation and landscaping timeline during 2/12 meeting.

Highlands & Northaven Gulley - Caitlin to investigate status of irrigation and landscaping timeline during 2/12 meeting.

Storm Drain effluent into MUD areas - map & trash clean-up presented during applicable MUD meetings.

Lighting - lighting map and database in process of completion

Silver Pole (PEC) - MUD / Promenade & Persia (2), Campo Del Sol (2) pending Beckett scheduling Black Pole (SCA) - two fixtures on Firecracker missing light heads. Becket Electric to be notified.

Neighborhood sidewalk replacement - number of damaged walks identified and repair is in 2024 proposed budget. Once approved, replacement will be contracted. Residents to use "Service Request" to report damaged walks. A list of pending repairs and map to be posted to the Sunfield portal.

Neighborhood Monuments - installation pending for Autumn Sage / Highlands / Northaven / Windridge

**Fire Hydrants** - creation of fire hydrant location map in process and when completed will be shared with BFD. Adjacent hydrant curbs to be painted red with no parking to the legal distance from each side of the hydrant.

Main Street Frontage Rd. To Firecracker - I35 frontage to @ oil change / carwash to be upgraded to 5 lanes. Two eastbound lanes (more merge distance) + three westbound lanes with dedicated right turn. Fall construction. Main St. full length I35 frontage to Firecracker to be 5 lane divided. Pending funding.

Main St. & Firecracker intersection to receive traffic control lights (Buda / HaysCo funded). Fall construction.

Main Street Extension - storm drain installation in process w/ curb-sidewalk-road surface installation pending

2001 Speed Limit / Stop Light - 50 mph to Sunbright, 55 to Satterwhite, signage to be installed. Sunbright & 2001 traffic control lights approved. Pending funding TXDOT, Hays Co Transportation Dept. Sunfield Elementary School - Richard, Nyssa, & Angie to work on student mobility plan (HS, MS, ES)

Student transportation: walk, virtual school bus, bicycle, golf cart, car parking, car pick-up line, school bus.

MUD 1/3/4 - MUD elections May 4th, 2024 / filing deadline February 16th. See notes under strategic plans.
