Subcommittee updates (60 min) Review Trello project tracking system

1) Amenities (Cassaundra, Earrick, Mandy, Nate, Amy)

Lazy River - cleaning (algae, bottom, skimmers, grates), rules (access, wristbands, vaping)

FSR unhappy with Commercial Swim performance, meeting with them at Lazy River to address expectations and outline cleaning process for existing algae. SCA Board wants to provide opportunity for Commercial Swim to address deficiencies. If plan to address algae removal is not adequate, may need to shut down for @ 2 weeks to drain and clean. Additional issues to be discussed with Pool Art (LR contractor). Several issues to be addressed in the off season (chemical auto feeder, water auto fill, circulation pumps, leaks).

Notification regarding fob use and wearing of wristbands will be sent to residents as well as emphasizing requirement with pool monitors. A "No Smoking / No Vaping" sign will be added to the back wall of the restroom building.

Ponds - Sunfield Parkway Pond rebuild

Engineering has been done but no communication on contractor to perform dredging and rebuild.

Letter sent to FSR & Scarborough Lane Development reflecting great displeasure with the lack of progress in repairing the Sunfield Parkway Ponds (copy attached)

Disc Golf - minimal number of baskets

No response from the board on status of old equipment or potential for new equipment and establishing several baskets in a community area.

3rd Amenity - features / timing

This will be a water amenity with plans to be operational for the 2025 season.

Playgrounds

Considering addition of play equipment adjacent to the Reunion Pavilion, in community area of Phase 3 Sec. 6. Propose also considering between Phase 4 Sec. 1 & 2 adjacent to the Mail Kiosk.

All patios and sidewalk additions require ARC approval.

Landscape material

Specific materials are called out as not acceptable in the design guidelines. All material not specifically reapproved by the design guidelines and rules and regulations must be approved by the ARC.
